- Some of the lectures in the course will be given in English since one of the lecturers (Guilherme) has limitations to teach in Swedish. However this should not be a major issue, since the examiner (Jan-Åke Larsson) is Swedish, and the report that will be handed in as part of the evaluation is to be submitted written in Swedish.
- The main communication channels will be the Lisam course room and email. Teams may also be used if you need to reach us. **This course will be given on campus.** You can see the corresponding room for each lecture in TimeEdit and in the front page of the Lisam course room.
- If you have any cold-like symptoms you should not come to the lecture. In order to minimize any problems with the fact you will not have watched one or more lectures, the videos from the lectures from last year will be available after each corresponding lecture.
